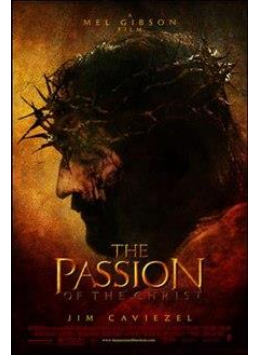
Struggle, Suffering, Faith and Hope

Love In Action – Food Pantry Garden Night

Tuesday, September 29th 3:45-6:45pm in person (+assigned videos prior)



One of the many struggles that people living in poverty face is having consistent access to fresh fruits and vegetables. Fortunately, here in Madison we have an amazing organization set up – the Madison Area Food Pantry Gardens – that works to meet this need. In this mini course, we will watch a few videos on Catholic Social Teaching and care for those in poverty, then meet outdoors to discuss what we learned. We'll then walk up to the Forward Garden, one of the food pantry gardens, to serve our neighbors in need.

This course will meet first at the Pope Farm Conservancy & then service and pick-up will be at the Forward Garden next-door. Registration is required by Fri. 9/25 with a limit of four participants.

Miracles, Faith and Service

Saturday, October 10, 1-6pm

We are the people of the miracle. We believe in Miracles – we believe that Miracles happen each time we come to Mass..... We'll talk about Miracles – and how our faith in Miracles (like in the Miracle of the Resurrection, and the Miracles that Jesus did) calls us to live in faith and in service. The mini-course includes a movie (you'll have a selection of miracle movies from which to choose!), discussion of miracles in the Bible as well as in the moview – and in life, a service project helping homeless kids, and weekend liturgy.
